Mission & Welcome Statement

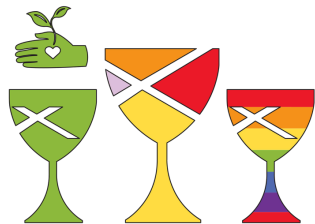
Our congregation believes we are called by God to reflect and celebrate the love and teachings of Jesus Christ.
